Confidential Resources and Reporting Options:

All individuals are encouraged to make a prompt report to law enforcement and to the University. An individual may seek confidential support and resources as designated below. Confidential resources will *not* share information with the University nor will speaking with a confidential resource trigger action by the University under most circumstances. We encourage all individuals to make a prompt report to the University using the reporting options below, but we recognize that individuals may choose to make a report of sexual harassment, misconduct or violence to *any* university employee. With the exception of confidential resources, all other university, including student employees who have responsibility for student welfare, are trained to share the report with a Title IX Coordinator or Deputy Coordinator of the University to ensure prompt and equitable review, investigation and resolution.
